Health Research Scheme of DHR

The scheme is intended to create a pool of talented health research personnel in the country by upgrading skills of faculty of medical colleges, mid-career scientists, medical students and others. The goal of this program is to encourage and support the trainees to develop and take up research projects for addressing health problems of national relevance.

About ICMR-NIRRCH

NIRRCH is a premier ICMR Institute which conducts basic, clinical, operational and socio-behavioral research in women's health, maternal and child health, female and male infertility, genetic disorders and infectious diseases. The Institute houses excellent infrastructure for conducting fundamental and applied research. It also offers clinical services for family welfare, infertility, child health, women's health and bone health.

About the Course

The course aims at imparting conceptual and technical know-how on "Omics" tools used in clinical practice and biomedical research. This 4-week course will cover lectures, lab tutorials and interactive sessions on genetics, epigenetics, genomics, metagenomics, proteomics and metabolomics tools. Participants will be given hands on training for karyotyping, FISH, PCR, RFLP, DNA sequencing, real time PCR, metagenomics, bioinformatics. In addition, there will be demonstrations on techniques such as pyro sequencing, flow cytometry, confocal microscopy, microarray and others. The course also comprises a module on Research Methodology. The participants will also be exposed to statistical analysis tools and training in developing research proposals and grant writing. - Faculty of medical colleges, Model Rural Health Research Units (MRHRUs), Multidisciplinary Research Units (MRUs) and research institutes/universities with MBBS/MD/PhD degree.
- > Limited seats are available for candidates pursuing MD.
- > Candidates from North-East and semi-urban/rural regions of India are encouraged to apply.
- Candidates in service should forward their application through proper channel with a "No Objection Certificate" from the head of the Institution.
