

Sir.

As you are aware that the 'New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019' was notified in the Gazette of India vide G.S.R.227 (E) dated 19.03.2019 wherein, Chapter IV of this rules mandates that, all ethics committees related to biomedical and health research involving human participants shall be required to register with the authority designated by the Central Government in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Health Research (DHR).

- Accordingly, the 'National Ethics Committee Registry for Biomedical and Health Research (NECRBHR), was set up at the Department of Health Research in 2019 to facilitate the processing of such applications, seeking registration of ethics committees for biomedical and health research involving human participants. With effect from 15.09.2019, it is a mandatory requirement under law for those ethics committees conducting or intending to conduct biomedical and health research, involving human participants, to get registered with the designated authority in the DHR. In this regard, earlier vide letters of even number dated 12th September, 2019 and 2nd June, 2022 (copies enclosed), the Directors of concerned ICMR Institutes were also requested to ensure that the Ethics Committees of their respective Institutes are registered with NECRBHR, DHR.
- In view of the above, it is again requested to kindly ensure to 3. get registered their respective institutes' Ethics Committee with NECRBHR, DHR at the earliest. The Institutes which are already at various stages of registration on the Naitik portal are requested to kindly expedite their process urgently. It may kindly be noted that in Cur

Subject: Registration of Ethics Committees for Biomedical and Health Research with National Ethics Committee Registry for Biomedical and Health Research, DHR-Regarding.

Sir/Madam.

Lam directed to say that, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 (23 of 1940), the Central Government, in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Health and Family Welfare, has notified the 'New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019', on 19.03.2019, in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary)- Part-II, Section 3, Sub-section (i), vide G.S.R.227 (E) dated 19.03.2019. The above Rules, except Chapter-IV thereof, have come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette, i.e., w.e.f. 19.03.2019. The Chapter IV of the aforesaid Rules, relating to Ethics Committees for Biomedical and Health Research, involving human participants, came into force on expiry of 180 days from the date of publication of the above Rules, i.e., after 14.09.2019.

- 2. The Chapter IV of the above Rules provides that any institution or organization, etc., which intends to conduct biomedical and health research, shall be required to have an Ethics Committee to review and oversee the conduct of such research, as detailed in the 'National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants', specified by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). In compliance to the sub-rule (I) of rule 17, an authority has already been designated by the DHR for registration of Ethics Committees for biomedical and health research involving human participants, vide this Department's Office Order No. U-11024/01/2018-HR (Part)/8006615 dated 12.09.2019 (Encl. 1). Also, a set-up, with the nomenclature 'National Ethics Committee Registry for Biomedical and Health Research' (NECRBHR), has been put in place within the Department of Health Research, vide this Department's ID Note No. U-11024/01/2018-HR (Part-2)/8015255 dated 12.09.2019 (Encl. 2), to facilitate receipt and processing of applications seeking registration, and to assist the authority, thus designated, in the discharge of its duties. A communication was also sent to the Secretaries/Principal Secretaries, Health and Family Welfare Departments of all the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations to bring the provisions of this rule into the

notice of all the entities institutions researchers stake holders in their respective. State/U1 vide letter No U 11024/01/2018 HR (part-2) 8015255 dated 13th September 2019 (Encl. 3).

- The entire process of receipt and processing of the applications, seeking registration of ethics committees for biomedical and health research involving human participants, shall be carried out in the DHR via online process only. For this purpose, a portal has been developed, to facilitate the task, with the domain name "naitik.gov.in". All entities/institutions/medical colleges/researchers/stakeholders, etc. whether in public or private and, who are conducting or intending to conduct biomedical and health research involving human participants, are required to register their Ethics Committees on the above portal. It is now a mandatory requirement, with effect from 15.09.2019, for those ethics committees conducting or intending to conduct biomedical and health research, involving human participants, to get registered with the designated authority in the DHR.
- 5. In view of the above, it may please be ensured that all such ethics committees involved in Biomedical and Health Research in your Institutions, get themselves registered with Department of Health Research immediately.

Subject: Registration of Ethics Committees for Biomedical and Health Research Regarding

Sir/Madam.

I am directed to say that, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 (23 of 1940), the Central Government, in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Health and Family Welfare, has notified the 'New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019', on 19.03.2019, in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary) - Part-II, Section 3, Sub-section (i), vide G.S.R.227 (E) dated 19.03.2019. The above Rules, except Chapter-IV thereof, have come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette, i.e., w.e.f. 19.03.2019. The Chapter IV of the aforesaid Rules, relating to Ethics Committees for Biomedical and Health Research, involving human participants, shall come into force on expiry of 180 days from the date of publication of the above Rules, i.e., after 14.09.2019.

- 2. The Chapter IV of the above Rules provides that any institution or organization, etc., which intends to conduct biomedical and health research, shall be required to have an Ethics Committee to review and oversee the conduct of such research, as detailed in the 'National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants', specified by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). These guidelines may be seen at the website of the Department of Health Research https://dhr.gov.in under 'Important Links' with the heading 'National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants 'download'.
- 3. The sub-rule (1) of rule 17 of these Rules provides that such an Ethics Committee to be constituted in accordance with the said guidelines shall register itself with the authority to be designated for the purpose by the Department of Health Research (DHR) in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. In this regard, an authority has already been designated by the DHR for registration of Ethics Committees for biomedical and health research involving human participants, vide this Department's Office Order No.U-11024/01/2018-HR (Part)/8006615 dated 12.09.2019. Also, a set-up, with the nomenclature 'National Ethics Committee Registry for Biomedical and Health Research' (NECRBHR), has been put in place within the Department of Health Research, vide this Department's 1D Note No. U-11024/01/2018-HR (Part)/8006615 dated 12.09.2019, to

facilitate receipt and processing of applications seeking registration, and to assist the authority, thus designated, in the discharge of its duties.

- 4. The entire process of receipt and processing of the applications, seeking registration of ethics committees for biomedical and health research involving human participants, shall be carried out in the DHR online only. For this purpose, a portal has been developed, to facilitate the task, with the domain name "naitik.gov.in". All entities/institutions/medical colleges/researchers/stakeholders, etc. whether in public or private and, who are conducting or intending to conduct biomedical and health research involving human participants, are required to submit proposal (s) for registration of Ethics Committees on the above portal. It is now a mandatory requirement, with effect from 15.09.2019, for getting all those ethics committees for biomedical and health research, involving human participants, registered with the designated authority in the DHR.
- 5. In view of the above, it is requested that attention of all the entities/ institutions/ researchers/stakeholders in your State/ Union Territory whether in public of private, and who are conducting or intending to conduct biomedical and health research, involving human participants may be drawn to the requirement for registration of Ethics Committees for Biomedical and Health Research in terms of the provisions of Chapter-IV of the 'New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019' with the designated authority in the Department of Health Research w.e.f. 15.09.2019

The sub-rule (1) of rule 17 of the New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019 provides that an ethics committee, constituted under rule 16 of the aforesaid Rules, for the purpose of biomedical and health research involving human participants, shall be required to register with the authority, to be designated by the Central Government in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Department of Health Research.

2. Accordingly, with the approval of the Competent Authority, the incumbent of the post of Joint Secretary in the Department of Health Research, under whose charge the subject of biomedical and health research involving human participants is dealt with, is designated as the authority, who shall discharge, on ex-officio basis, all the functions assigned to such an authority under the said rules, namely, the 'New Drugs and Clinical Trials Rules, 2019'.
