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The periodical report publications by National Cancer Registry Programme of India have achieved the objective of dissemination of evidence based information on cancer in India and the World. The reports have been cited by various National and International Indexed Journals on Cancer/Non Communicable Diseases.

Besides being a source of authentic information for media, the reports have been cited in 1000+ articles by researchers/clinicians/Public Health Bodies during the period 1982 to 2016. This is indicative of the fact that most of the scientific data contribution in the area of cancer in India and for India as part of the world has emerged using National Cancer Registry Programme's data as baseline. Since scientific research is an ongoing process, the numbers of such citations are ever increasing.
