Sir/Madam,

Synchronization of data and datasets collected and disseminated by the Central Ministries/ Departments/Organizations and State administrative Departments/Organizations has been a long-felt need in the National Statistical System. In this regard, attention is invited to Principle 3 of the United Nations Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics (UNFPOS), adopted by the Government of India in 2016, which emphasizes facilitating correct interpretation of data through the application of scientific standards relating to sources, methods, and procedures.

2. Accordingly, the definitions of Pucca, Semi-Pucca and Kutcha houses, along with the classification of roof, wall and floor materials, have been reconciled after consultations with the concerned stakeholder Ministries/Departments/Organizations, including the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), and have been approved by the National Statistical Commission (NSC). In this context, bamboo treated with preservatives has been classified as a pucca material, while raw bamboo continues to be treated as kutcha. All stakeholder Ministries/ Departments/Organizations are requested to adopt these harmonized definitions with immediate effect to ensure consistency in housing-related datasets.

3. In this regard, the undersigned is directed to forward the Office Memorandum of this Ministry dated 16th December 2025 for your kind perusal and necessary action.

Office Memorandum

Subject:- Harmonization of definitions of Kutcha/Pucca Houses across various Government Surveys, Census and Administrative Sources in Government of India.

Reference is invited to our OM dated 16.12.2025 (copy enclosed) regarding harmonization of divergences in the definition of Kutcha/Pucca Houses emerging from various Surveys, Censuses and other administrative data Sources in Government of India.

2. In this context, a clarification on definition of bamboo treated with preservatives has been sought by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

3. In this regard, based on the clarification by the Institute of Wood Science and Technology (IWST), the following is informed:

As per Clause 5.1.2 of IS 15912: 2018 (Structural Design using bamboo-Code Practice), bamboo species for structural use in housing construction shall be treated in accordance with IS 9096: 2006 (RA 2018).


IS 9096: 2006 recommends different preservatives, their concentration and absorption and the method of treatment of Indian bamboo species to be used for structural purposes. The different types of preservatives for different structural uses are a) Coal Tar Creosote, b) Acid Curpic Chromate Composition, c) Copper Chrome Boron Composition, d) Boric Acid Borax and e) Copper Zinc Naphthenate/Abietates. Bamboos can be treated by brushing, dipping, vacuum pressure process, hot and cold process, fast fluctuating pressure (FFP) process and by Boucherie process.

4. Accordingly, bamboo treated with preservative used in pucca houses involves bamboo that has been impregnated with preservatives such as boric acid and borax, or other approved chemicals, to protect against termites, fungi, and decay. The treatment is applied through soaking or pressure methods to ensure deep penetration, and the bamboo is dried to maintain low moisture content for durability.

5. It is requested that all the stakeholder Ministries/Departments/Organizations adopt the above criteria for classifying bamboo treated with preservatives to ensure consistencies in the datasets produced across the country.

6. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.

Office Memorandum

Subject: Reconciliation of divergent definitions of Pucca/Semi Pucca/Kutcha Housing Structure used by different Government Agencies

Synchronization of data/datasets collected and disseminated by the Central Ministry/Departments/Organizations, and State administrative Departments/Organizations, has been a long felt need in the National Statistics Office.

2. Principle 3 of the United Nations Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics (UNFPOS), as adopted by the Government of India in 2016, provides for facilitating a correct interpretation of the data. The statistical agencies are to present information according to scientific standards on the sources, methods and procedures of the statistics.

3. Reference is also invited to letter no. F-23015/61/2024-ASPD dated 03.01.2025 on *Mechanism for reconciliation of divergent datasets* vide which it was requested that Ministry/Departments may refer matters of definitional divergences in concepts that are being used in surveys/ censuses and datasets for action as appropriate.

4. Some time back this Ministry received a reference from NITI Aayog requesting to reconcile the definitional divergences in the definition of kutcha/pucca houses between NFHS and NSS surveys and Population Census. In addition, the communication of the NITI Aayog, also placed on record the request of State of Nagaland that houses made of bamboo may not be considered as kutcha house.

5. In this regard, it was observed that five government agencies viz. NSS, MoH&FW, MoRD, MoHUA and ORGI follow different definitions of a Pucca/Semi Pucca/Kutcha Structure. Hence, after several meetings with the stakeholder Ministries/Departments/Organizations including Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) the definition of the Pucca/Semi-Pucca/Kutcha structure along with the list of materials classifying Roof/Wall/Floor as Pucca/Kutcha have been reconciled and the same have been approved by the National Statistical Commission (NSC).

6. Accordingly, the approved standard definitions of the Pucca/Semi Pucca/Kutcha Houses for the surveys/census etc. are as under:

- a) Pucca: Both roof and walls made of pucca materials.
- b) Semi-Pucca: Either roof or wall made of kutcha material.
- c) Kutcha: Both roof and walls made of kutcha materials.

7. Further, the list of building materials classifying Roof/Wall/Floor as Pucca/Kutchra are attached at Annexure.

8. In case of Bamboo as the building material for houses, NSC accepted the recommendation that Bamboo treated with preservatives to be classified as a Pucca material for use in roofs and walls, while raw bamboo will continue to be treated as a Kutchra material for the same.

9. It is requested that all the stakeholder Ministries/Departments/Organizations adopt the above harmonized definitions to ensure consistencies in the datasets produced across the country.

10. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.


