<u>Infectious Disease Research and Diagnostic Laboratories</u>

The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) is in the process of establishing "Infectious Disease Research and Diagnostic Laboratories (IRDLs)" in State/Central Govt run institutes and medical colleges with functioning Virus Research and Diagnostic Laboratories (VRDLs), with the view of strengthening the verticals of diagnostic Bacteriology, Mycology and Parasitology. These institutes shall serve as Regional Referral level labs for diagnosis and research on infectious diseases, and shall be supported by ICMR with funding for equipment, infrastructure, manpower and consumables. These institutes shall have the following mandate:

- Quality assured advanced diagnostic testing of infectious diseases, including outbreak investigation
- Syndromic surveillance of infectious diseases
- Role as biorepositories/biobanks with well characterized relevant microbe strains and clinical samples
- Role as certified PT panel providers for infectious disease testing
- Role as accredited in-vitro diagnostics evaluation centers

ICMR has shortlisted ten (10) VRDLs for the establishment of IRDLs in the pilot phase through rigorous internal and external review, including on-site assessment. These sites (enlisted in Table 1) are in various stages of IRDL establishment.


